## 1 Introduction

#### Object

The "Trophee de Paris" is an international Audio Visual competition, together with an author's meeting, open to all AV workers, amateur or professional, around the world

#### Patronage

The "Trophee de Paris" is run under the patronage patronage of

### **Organizers**

The "Trophée de Paris" is organized by a collective composed of independent people:

#### Jury

A jury composed of five people competent in the artistic, photographic and audiovisual fields will view all the works received.

There will be no preselection.

The jury will meet before the date of the meetings to collectively determine the final ranking.

#### Patronage

The "Trophée de Paris" is placed under the patronage :

### **Prizes**

The winner of the Grand Prix will receive an engraved medal of the Paris coin which is the logo of the "Paris Trophy".

The FIAP medals (Gold, Silver and Bronze), the FPF trophy as well as the FIAP Honorable Mentions, will be awarded to those next in the ranking order.

The potential profit from the sum of the registration fee minus the organizational costs will be distributed to the authors who are at the top of the list.

### 2. The competition

# Conditions of entry

- The competition is open to all, with the exception of those involved in the organization and the jury.
- Entries are limited to one sequence per author.
- However, the author's name may appear twice if co-productions are entered.
- Sequences which have been entered in a previous edition of the "Paris Trophy" will not be accepted.
- Subject matter is free but propaganda or offensive material will not be allowed.
- The entire sequence should be based on the single photographic image, however the inclusion of video clips may be tolerated provided they are not predominant in the production.
- The editing file in mp4, mpeg, wmv or exe format (preferably in mp4 format)
- Large files which cannot be projected correctly with the equipment available to the organisers will not be selected.
- The maximum duration allowed is 12 minutes.

#### Submission of entries

Entries must include:

- The editing file in mp4, mpeg, wmv or exe format (prefer mp4 format)
- A poster (jpeg format, dimensions 1920 × 1080 pixels maximum)
- A portrait of the author (jpeg format, dimensions 1920 × 1080 pixels maximum)
- An identification sheet (fiche) which is available for download from the website.
- Non francophone works must be accompanied by a summary in French or in English.

A catalog will be sent to all participants. This will include:

- the alphabetical list established by country and by author with the titles of accepted works,
- a statistical table of the event.

This catalog will be downloadable on the "Trophée de Paris" website.

# **Retention of sequences**

The participants in the "Paris Trophy" allow the organizers to use their works during public sessions or to promote the discipline.

The organizers undertake not to transmit the works to third parties or to place them on the Internet without the authorization of the author.

# Date and place

A day of meetings, projections and exchanges is organized

# 4. Processing of personal data

## 5. Special conditions of FIAP

By submitting his works to a show under FIAP Patronage, the participant accepts without exception and without objection the following terms: "- that the images submitted may be examined by FIAP to establish whether they comply with the FIAP rules and definitions, even if if the participant is not a member of FIAP, - that FIAP can use all the means at its disposal for this company, - that any refusal to cooperate with FIAP or any refusal to submit the original files taken by the camera or, failure to provide sufficient evidence will be sanctioned by FIAP, - that in case of sanctions following violations of FIAP rules, the name of the participant will be published in any form useful to inform the organizers of these offenses. -I expressly agree with the provisions of the FIAP regulation 2014/317 "Terms of application for sponsorship and rules for the organization of international photographic events and in particular chapter II.2 concerning the rules of participation and the red list.
